Aerie Secretary Report

Brothers and Sisters,

Welcome to December (April Fools!!!!). It is April and the year is flying by. We brought in 10 more new members to the Aerie this past month and had 2 re-enrollees. Thanks to all the members that sponsored a new member, because you have helped us exceed our net gain number and our 2% growth goal for the year. We not only exceeded them, we currently are 20 members over net gain and 30 members over our goal and we still have new member applications coming in. However, if you sponsor a person for membership, please, look over the application. We have received applications with no last name on it and several that had unreadable names, phone numbers, emails, etc. and some that were not completed on the back of the application. It is very important that we get this information correct because, it is how we reach out to these people for interviews and subsequently, initiation. This information is also sent to the Grand Aerie and is the only way they can contact a member, if necessary.

Now that I have told you the good news, I want to let you know that we need to look to the future. Our Fiscal year ends May 31 and that is when most of the members dues expire. So we are starting in earnest to try to get everyone to pay their dues for next year. We have a contest going for everyone that pays their dues on or before April 15th. Their names will be put in a drawing for 3 gift cards: a \$50, a \$25 and another \$25 and we have 3 cards for both the Aerie and the Auxiliary. I have processed all of our active military and life members and we have had a few members pay their dues, but we have a long way to go. If your dues are due, you should have gotten a reminder letter from the Grand Aerie which were mailed out the end of March. VERY IMPORTANT - if your current membership card said that your dues expire May 31, 2023, and you did not get one of these letters, please get with me or one of the other officers and give them your current address because it must be wrong in our records and we need to get this corrected. The Grand Aerie will send out 1 letter each month in March, April and May and the Aerie has to pay for these mailings, so, the sooner you renew your dues, the better it is for your Aerie. As a reminder, dues for under 65 are \$36 and for 65 and older they are \$24. You can pay by mailing them in to Eagles 3496, 1900 S. Goldenrod Rd, Orlando, FL 32822, or paying at the bar or putting them in an envelope and dropping them in the Aerie drop box in the entrance to the club.

Again, thank you all for supporting the Aerie. Thank you, thank you to all our Aerie and Auxiliary members that come out and support our charities and our organization. And God Bless our volunteers, for you are the life blood of this organization. Looking forward to another exciting Eagle year visiting with all of you and celebrating renewed friendships and fellowship.




