# Aerie Secretary Report

Brothers and Sisters,



Here we are in May already. It won't be long until it is June. Really depressing. We brought in 6 more new members to the Aerie this past month and had 3 new applications. Thanks to Dave Zimmer and Curtis Johnson for all of their work with interviews. It seems like an easy task, but they have to call each new applicant, usually several times, to get them in for the interview. And sometimes they have to come in on different days to be as accommodating as they can trying to get everyone interviewed. If you sponsor a person for membership, please, look over the application to make sure it is complete and legible. It is very important that we get this information correct because, it is how we reach out to these people for interviews and subsequently, initiation. This information is also sent to the Grand Aerie and is the only way they can contact a member, if necessary.

Remember, our fiscal year ends May 31 and that is when most of the members dues expire. So, we are starting in earnest to try to get everyone to pay their dues for next year. The contest that we had for everyone that paid their dues by April 16th has ended. It was a little disappointing that we only had 211 members renew their dues before the deadline and 58 of those were life members and active military and they don't have to renew each year. I do it for them so they don't get dues notices. We have over 500 Aerie members, so there are still 300 members that are getting another dues notice and the Grand Aerie. If your dues are due, you should have gotten two letters from the Grand Aerie which were mailed out in March and April. **VERY IMPORTANT** - if your current membership card said that your dues expire May 31, 2023, and you did not get one of these letters, please get with me or one of the other officers and give them your current address because it must be wrong in our records and we need to get this corrected. The Grand Aerie will send out 1 letter each month in March, April and May and we will have to pay for the printing and mailing, so, the sooner you renew your dues, the better it is for your Aerie. As a reminder, dues for under 65 are \$36 and for 65 and older they are \$24. You can pay by mailing them in to Eagles 3496, 1900 S. Goldenrod Rd, Orlando, Fl. 32822, or paying at the bar or putting them in an envelope and dropping them in the Aerie drop box in the entrance to the club.

The club has initiated a new email "Blast" program that sends an email to every member each week to let them know what is going on. If you have not received these blasts yet please see me or Melanie to verify your email address.

On a more serious note, we have had members playing the entertainment machines and switching them off and on trying to increase their odds of winning. We talked to the vendors that own the machines and they ensured us that this does not change your odds at all! In fact, it can damage the chipset on the computer boards in the machines. Also, it has been seen on the security cameras that we still have members vaping while in the game room playing the games. This is a violation of our House Rules! The Trustees have instituted a policy now that if anyone is caught turning any of the machines on and off or vaping it will be a mandatory 30 day suspension. You have been warned.

Again, thank you all for supporting the club. Thank you, thank you to all our Aerie and Auxiliary members that come out and support our charities and our organization. And God Bless our volunteers, for you are the life blood of this organization. Looking forward to another exciting Eagle year visiting with all of you and celebrating renewed friendships and fellowship.

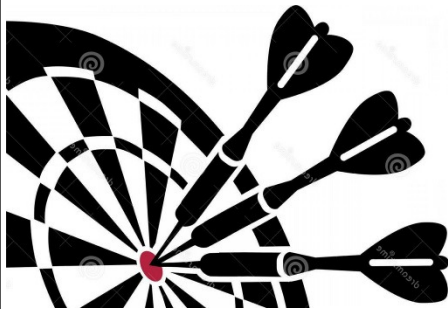

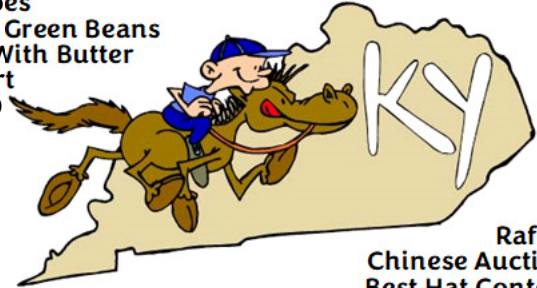

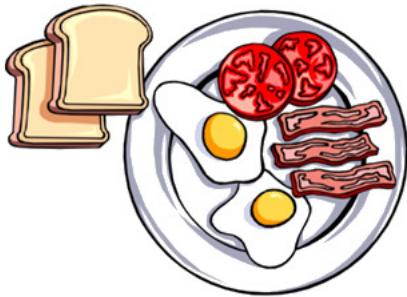
